It's apple harvest season in New York State! To show appreciation for NYS Farmers and provide local NYS Apples to schools, the FarmOn! Foundation in collaboration with New York Department of Agriculture and New York Apple Association are encouraging folks to sign up for the Big Apple Crunch and register to participate in the Scholarship Award for \$1000 to the winning school for a school garden, to help kids eat nutritious locally grown food from their own Victory Garden year round!

Participants from across the state are invited to take a bite out of a New York State apple to bring awareness to NYS Farmers during harvest season.

GrowNYC and the NYC Office of Food Policy and has only grown from there. Millions of students, schools and college campuses statewide join in every year to CRUNCH, POST UP & WIN!

The Big Apple Crunch Challenge Kicks off October 26th, 2023 at 2pm ET. Winners will be announced November 6th, 2023 at 12pET.

The school winner will receive a \$1000 Scholarship and FarmOn! Programming to plant or improve any school garden that provides fresh produce to better school lunch, fundraising opportunities with salad bars and helps farmers sell apples during harvest season to NYS schools.
